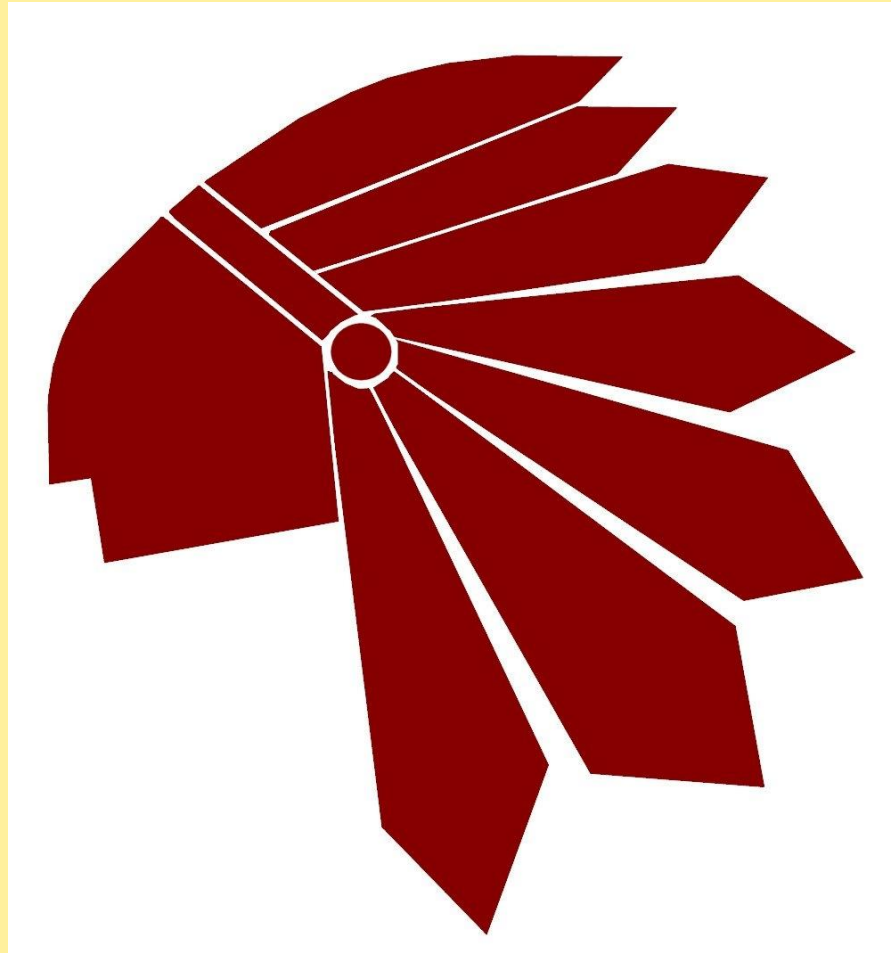
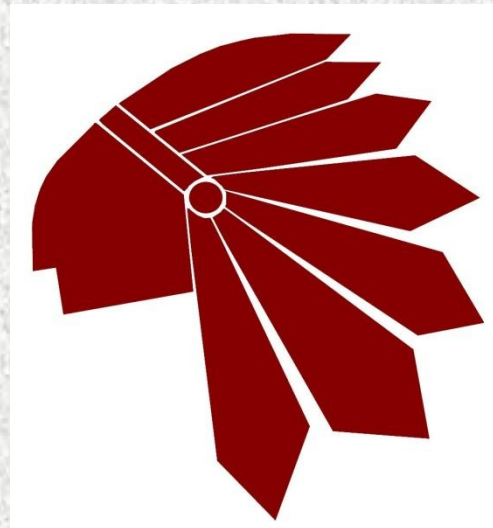


# WLC SCHEDULING PROPOSAL



# *Goals of WLC's New Schedule*

- **To increase student responsibility and accountability**
- **To provide opportunities for all members of our school community to collaborate**
- **To provide time necessary to offer additional academic supports to all students**
- **To create time for all students to access more of our program offerings (i.e. Band, Chorus, etc.)**
- **To strengthen our school community through the management of time.**



# *How We Developed WLC's New Schedule*

- Formed Scheduling Study Team Comprised of WLC staff members
- Discussed concerns with current 4x4 block schedule
- Established goals of new schedule
- Visited schools to experience a variety of schedule models
- Conducted teacher survey
- Solicited input from students
- Created proposed model for school community to review and discuss
- Held roundtable discussion with staff to “fine tune” proposed model
- Shared model with parents/ community at WLC Co-op Connection meetings
- Presented schedule model to Superintendent for approval
- Presented schedule model to School Board for approval
- Presented schedule model to students

# *WLC Schedule Summary*

- Advantages to students

- Freshmen and sophomores will receive year long instruction in core classes to provide better continuity in learning.
- Juniors and seniors will continue to experience the longer block, a good preparation for college;
- Juniors and senior will also have opportunities to design and implement a personal learning experience.
- All students will have an opportunity for “unstructured” time in the school day, during which they can access student services, participate in special events, or meet with faculty members without losing direct instruction time.

- Advantages to WLC programs

- Skills-based courses (math, languages, etc.) can run consecutively without large gaps of time between classes.
- The music programs are accessible to all students
- The flex-time period will provide a means by which credit recovery can occur thus allowing students who stumble to maintain forward progress towards graduation

- Advantages to faculty

- Faculty will have more opportunities to communicate with students outside the classroom.
- Faculty will have more opportunities to collaborate with colleagues on improving instruction for students.
