



**Nurse/Health Office**  
**(Extension 2126)**

Hours: 7:40 AM to 3:00 PM

The nurse's office is adjacent to the front office. Students who are ill or injured will report to the nurse or the school secretary if the nurse is not available. This is also the place to come for information about diseases, area clinics, the date of your last tetanus shot, etc.

Students who must take ANY prescriptions or over-the-counter medication while at school must bring it to the nurse's office, with a signed form from a parent/guardian and prescribing physician (forms available on WLC website). The medication must be in its original bottle, with the pharmacy label attached if it is a prescription medication. Any pharmacy will give you an extra bottle (with the prescription label attached) to leave at school.

Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen, Benadryl and Tums also require a parent permission form signed before they will be administered. *No phone permissions will be accepted.* Students who use inhalers for asthma may carry the inhaler with them, provided the student submits written consent from parent/guardian and physician/provider.

The State of New Hampshire requires that a school retain the medical records of a student for that student's term of enrollment only. Therefore the medical records of a senior will be given to him/her after graduation. The school will only retain records that reference an accident or incident in which the student may have been involved.
